Resumo (objetivos, atividades e resultados esperados) - em PT e/ou EN:	In terms of context The Starting Up – Accelerators of entrepreneurship 4 inclusion arises from previous works done from some of the partners in the context of special needs and young people with intellectual and developmental difficulties (IDDs) with a degree of incapacity up to 60%. As said in other places of this application, this group hasn't had opportunities to continue studies or to enter the labour market and are facing social and education exclusion. The National and

European context to offer an opportunity to address this issues and to help mitigate this differences. The social inclusion and integration of people with fewer opportunities is one of the flags of the European Commission and European States.

Our project is in line with some European priorities (EC, 2018) such as:

- a) Promoting the participation of people from disadvantaged groups with fewer opportunities and / or special needs;
- b) Increasing equality and inclusion, and participants from geographical areas less represented in the Programme.

At national level, for example, Portugal recently approved a law that forces larges enterprises and organisations to a have a minimum number of employees with disabilities and also our project is in line with the initiative INCoDe20.30.

It's a start, but more that having laws we must, as society, understand this problematic (by giving it visibility) and be the major responsible for the change.
