Resumo (objetivos, atividades e resultados esperados) - em PT e/ou EN:	<p>The project entitled E-(m)PACT project is about healthcare education, simulation and media embedded and its main objectives are:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. To improve the quality of education in the field of HC (healthcare) by delivering tools and guidance for the trainers and students on how to implement and work with simulation (a form of work-based learning in the school) and media at basic level. The use of simulation is expected to enhance learning and facilitate the transition from school to the labor market, improving the relevant skills of the students. The partnership will produce a guide on how to start simulation activities in the schools and how to make use of media tools to support these activities. 2. To make HC education more accessible and attractive for the students by expanding the learning space and making more strategic and integrated use of ICT and QER in the training process. Therefore, the project will create a model for the development and use of tutorials in the partner institutions and will deliver a set of sample courses transformed in tutorials.

	<p>3. To foster the exchange of good practices among the partners and to combine their expertise in developing and delivering the intellectual results of the project, by organizing common learning and training activities for trainers and students. These activities are also foreseen to involve the main end-users in the development, testing and revising the main results of the project (that includes students), but also to make teachers have a better understanding of practices in HC education. The activities will also be an opportunity for professional development that will increase the motivation and satisfaction in their daily work.</p>
