Resumo (objetivos, atividades e resultados esperados) - em PT e/ou EN:	The overall objective of the project is to support VET centres and practitioners to understand the conceptual frameworks associated with integration and inclusion of migrant learners and subsequently build the transversal skills of educators through the development of new pedagogic materials and approaches to teaching and learning. Transversal skills (such as communication, collaboration, time mgt and problem solving) are not considered as being related to a specific task or knowledge area, but as skills that can be used in a wide variety of situations. The transversal skills of educators can be further strengthened at European level through results that would not be attained by activities carried out in a single country, as can each of the Transform project's key results. For example, the Competency Framework for the vocational integration of migrants and refugees in Europe (WP2) that is to be developed will be more inclusive of different cultures, traditions and customs if developed as a collective of European countries, with 180 VET professionals from different backgrounds involved. Similarly WP5 will better support the overall objective of inclusion and diversity in all fields of education.
